



BJF Navodaya Mission 2025-26

This is coaching primary school children from rural Punjab to help them get admissions on rural seats in Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas (JNV), fully residential government schools with classes from VI to XII standard. JNV conducts entrance test annually where 80 students are selected in each JNV school. We coach primary school students for clearing the entrance test through our BJF Navodaya Mission. This benefits the student by imparting **free high-quality education for 7 years** & preventing school drop-outs which otherwise lead to uneducated, unskilled, unemployable youth likely to get into crime & drugs. **The financial benefit to a student through admission in JNV is approximately INR 1.5 Lakhs per year.**

By far, 1452 students have qualified for admission to different JNV schools out of the 19,963 students taught under BJF Navodaya Mission across 112 centres in 19 districts of Punjab.

Eligibility:

- (i) The applicant should be a resident of Punjab or Chandigarh
- (ii) The age of the applicant should be between 10 to 12 years of age.
- (iii) The applicant should have studied at the same school for the past 3 years i.e., in Classes III, IV & V.
