

## **Instructions to the Candidates for BJF Stars 2028 Phase II Entrance Test:**

1. **Only those students who did not appear for the Phase I test conducted on 21 December 2025 are eligible to appear for this test.**
2. Please check your details here on the website and report to the test centre on the specified date and time.
3. Report at the allotted test centre at sharp **9:30 am on February 1, 2025 (Sunday)**.
4. Carry a **photo identity proof** such as School ID or AADHAR for verification.
5. A **registration fee of Rs. 100/-** must be deposited at the exam centre. Please bring the exact amount in cash with you.
6. Sit only on the seat allotted to you as per your roll number.
7. Ensure that you sign the attendance sheet during the examination.
8. In case you have not pasted the photograph on the application form, submit a **passport-size photograph** with your name and roll number written at the back of the photograph to the invigilator when you sign the attendance sheet.
9. Use **only blue or black ball point pen** to fill in details and responses on the Test Booklet and Answer Sheet.
10. The entrance test will consist of following parts:
  - A Mental Maths test with objective questions
  - A Screening Test with objective questions from Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology
  - A Punjabi writing/comprehension section
  - An English writing/comprehension section
11. Fill in your details on the response sheet and the question paper first, and then proceed to read or solve the question paper.
12. Calculators, log tables, mobile phones, pagers, communication devices, slide rules, geometry box, text material, etc. are not allowed inside the examination hall.
13. On completion of the test, hand over the Test Booklet and the Answer Sheet to the invigilator and then only leave the examination hall. **You are not permitted to take any test material with you.**
14. Any candidate who does not comply with the instructions or is found using unfair means, communicating with other candidates, or misbehaving with the invigilation staff will be debarred from the test and required to leave the examination hall immediately.
